# Apple & Pumpkin Festival

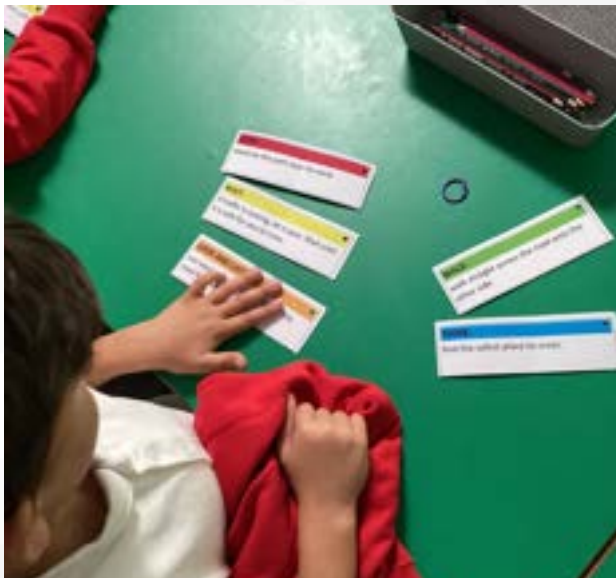

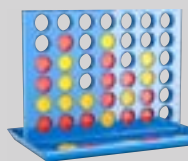
