On Monday 19th March we staged a whole-school Easter event called *Experience Easter*. This comprised six stations that told the different parts of the Easter Story and complimented the children's Religious Education learning. Led by the Year 6 children, the rest of the pupils in the school worked their way around the six stations of the cross. Through this they had the chance to explore various aspects of the Easter story in a very practical way. These experiences included the chance to: reflect on hopes and dreams for the future, consider Jesus' suffering and to find out about the Last Supper and how Jesus encouraged his disciples to remember him through sharing bread and wine.

Some of the props used during this session are now on display in the front entrance so that the whole school community can remember and reflect on the Easter Story at this important time in the Christian Calendar.
