At the beginning of March, the Drama and Dance Group from Morland C of E Primary School in Ipswich participated in this year's 'Celebration' concerts at Snape Maltings. Working within the theme of 'A Vision For The Future', the group created a stunning ten minute performance based on the prophecies of Macbeth's witches.
