Staff and pupils at Sproughton Church of England Primary School are celebrating their recent letter from Ofsted. The school, in the idyllic village of Sproughton, serves the community, with 104 children on roll and continues to be GOOD.

The short inspection focused on challenge for the more able, phonics and outcomes in the Early Years Foundation Stage and Key Stage One. The report is a celebration of all that has been achieved in those areas to date.
