

MAT Maths across the Curriculum Day October 2023

The children in each class applied their maths skills in their science learning.


The Children in reception class read *It was a Cold, Dark Night*. They then sorted the animals in the book into groups: those with 2 legs and those with 4.



Year 1 wondered if the tallest children had the biggest feet. They measured their feet with cubes.



Children in Year 5 explored the constellations. They measured the angles in each constellation.



Year 2 were investigating hand size and whether older children could pick up more cubes than younger children. They tested two children from each year group. Their results showed them that a Year 4 child picked up the most cubes, despite not being the oldest child in the sample. They came to the conclusion that the size of the person was more important than a person's age.



Children in year 3 investigated which magnets could attract the most nails.
